**Notes:**

It is important to know what weed infestations are already present before a development takes place. Since most developments are a source of ground disturbance, noxious weed infestations typically get much worse afterwards. Weeds should ideally be eliminated before development as it is much easier and cheaper to address infestations before disturbance occurs.

**Product rates can always be found on the product label or La Plata County Weed Cards.**

Some herbicides are not for use under or close to trees (Milestone). **Always read and follow the label.**

**Don't waste your time & money, always calibrate your sprayer before making treatments!**

Always add surfactant (Spreader 90 spring/fall, MSO summer).

**Site rehabilitation after weeds are controlled-** Spraying/ digging, alone, is not effective unless future noxious weeds have competition to prevent further infestations.

**If there are few or no competitive plants in the infested area, you may rehabilitate with:**

- ☐ Dryland pasture mix ☐ Low grow mix in early to late November before significant snowfall  
☐ Irrigated grass mix during the growing season when water is available ☐ Wildflower mix
